**Grades 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>** – Young actors will learn how to behave naturally onstage, vocal and physical techniques, and how to develop a character. Sensory technique will be incorporated into improvisational work, scene study and monologues.
